#### **Discuss**

### **Adult and Student Discussion Questions**

- What is it that John has seen, heard, and touched referenced in verse 1?
- According to John, what is the foundation for christian fellowship?
- What is one purpose for writing this letter listed in this chapter?
- What is meant by the statement, "God is light and in him is no darkness at all"?

### Kids Discussion Questions

- Here, John calls Jesus "the life" (vs. 2). Why is this a good nickname for lesus?
- John says he wrote this letter so that our "joy may be complete" (vs. 4). What do we mean when we say "joy" and how can our joy be complete?
- John tells a wonderful thing in verse 9. Why is this promise in 1 John 9 so important?

# AMAZING GRACE - JOHN NEWTON

- 1 Amazing grace (how sweet the sound)that saved a wretch like me!I once was lost, but now am found,was blind, but now I see.
- 2 'Twas grace that taught my heart to fear, and grace my fears relieved; how precious did that grace appear the hour I first believed!
- 3 Through many dangers, toils and snares
  I have already come:
  'tis grace has brought me safe thus far,
  and grace will lead me home.
  - 4 The Lord has promised good to me, his word my hope secures; he will my shield and portion be as long as life endures.
- 5 Yes, when this flesh and heart shall fail, and mortal life shall cease: I shall possess, within the veil, a life of joy and peace.
- 6 The earth shall soon dissolve like snow, the sun forbear to shine; but God, who called me here below, will be forever mine.

## MONDAY CHRIST OUR ADVOCATE

### Read 1 John 2 1-14 Discuss

#### **Adult and Student Discussion Questions**

- What source of hope does John offer to those who recognize their sin?
- What is one mark of a genuine relationship with Christ according to this passage?
- What is the "new commandment"?

If we cannot claim to live sinless lives, then the only thing that can keep us from despairing before a holy God is that we have an Advocate in heaven and He pleads our case not on the basis of our perfection but of His propitiation. - John Piper

### **Kids Discussion Questions**

- Re-read verse 1. Why is it so important to John that the church he was writing to did not give into sin?
- As much as John does not want his readers to sin, he gives us hope for when we do sin at the end of verse 1: "if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous." What does it mean that Jesus is our advocate?
- John tells us just how important it is that we love one another within the church (vs. 9-10). What does real love look like?

## TUESDAY DO NOT LOVE THE WORLD

### Read 1 John 2:15-29

#### **Discuss**

### **Adult and Student Discussion Questions**

- What does John refer to with his use of the term "world" in verse 15? How does this differ from the "world" that God sent his son to die for in John 3:16?
- Who, according to John, will "abide forever," and how can we understand this in light of the Biblical emphasis that we are saved by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8)?
- Verse 19 gives a clue about the occasion of this letter. What happened within the church John was writing to?

### **Kids Discussion Questions**

- John tells us we should not love the world. This is different than the people of the world- we must love them! Rather, John is talking about the broken world we live in. What happened to the world that made it this way?
- John is concerned about those outside of this church who were lying about who Jesus is (vs.19-22). Why is it so important that we know exactly who Jesus is?
- If someone asked you who Jesus is, what would you say?

Read 1 John 3:1-10

#### **Discuss**

### **Adult and Student Discussion Questions**

- Who does John consider a child of God?
- What warning does John give to those who make a practice of sinning?
- What marks of genuine Christianity does John mention in this passage?

If you want to judge how well a person understands Christianity, find out how much he makes of the thought of being God's child, and having God as his Father. If this is not the thought that prompts and controls his worship and prayers and his whole outlook on life, it means that he does not understand Christianity very well at all. - J.I. Packer

- How did Jesus make us children of God (vs 1)?
- John tell us that one way we can know who has really become a child of God is by the way they live (vs. 6-7). What will real children of God live like?
- How does someone become a child of God?

- What does John warn us of in verse 18?
- What does verse 19 refer to which can "reassure our hearts"?

Jesus said, "By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another" (John 13:34-35). If you are not expressing proper Christian love to every member of your church, you are in disobedience to God and you are hindering the evangelistic work of your church. - Mark Dever

- Looking at verses 17 and 18, what does love look like?
- Who is one person from our church family you can show brotherly love to this week?
