Read Proverbs 23

Discuss

- In what sense does wealth "sprout wings" (vs. 5)?
- What is the "stingy" man calculating in verse 7?

- How can you "buy" or find these?

BE THOU MY VISION - MARY E. BYRNE

1 Be thou my vision, O Lord of my heart; naught be all else to me, save that thou art-thou my best thought by day or by night, waking or sleeping, thy presence my light.

2 Be thou my wisdom, and thou my true word; I ever with thee and thou with me, Lord; thou my great Father, I thy true son; thou in me dwelling, and I with thee one.

- What stands out to you about this passage?
- How can you apply verse 27 this week?
- What "instruction" was gained by Solomon's encounter with the overgrown field (vs. 30-32)?

Adult and Student Discussion Questions

- What stands out to you about this passage?
- What does Solomon mean when he says that it is a matter of God's glory to "conceal things" and that of kings to search things out (vs. 2)?
- What is Solomon's point in verses 6-7? (See also Luke 14:7-11)

In all their searching, the scientist should still keep this humble remembrance: It is the glory of God to conceal a matter. What I see amazes me, but God has concealed even greater treasures of knowledge and wisdom in His creation (Romans 1:19-20).
